March 17, 1922 - November 24, 2024

Wilma "Nickie" Meek, age 102, died on November 24 2024 of natural causes. Nickie was born in Frankenmuth, Michigan on March 17, 1922, daughter of Carl and Lorna Nuechterlein. She graduated from Arthur Hill High school in Saginaw, Michigan and from the University of Michigan School of Nursing in Ann Arbor in 1943. In 1944, she enlisted in the U.S. Navy as a LTJG with the Navy Nurse Corp. She was stationed in Great Lakes, Illinois and later at the Treasure Island Naval Base in San Francisco. She married her husband, Harry W. Meek, on Sept 1, 1945 at St. Paulus Lutheran Church in San Francisco. They moved to Yreka in November 1945.

Nickie was employed by the Siskiyou County General Hospital as a registered nurse for 25 years - 13 of which were as Day Supervisor. She was later employed as the Office Manager in the family business, Meek Insurance Service, until her retirement in 1987.

She was instrumental in starting the Lutheran church in Yreka and became a charter member of Mt. Zion Lutheran Church. She was also a Life Member of the Yreka Soroptimist Club - a member since 1974. The Soroptimists honored her by establishing a fellowship in her name. She was loved by so many who knew her.

Surviving her are her two sons, Steven Meek and Brian (Connie) Meek, all from Yreka; two granddaughters Amanda (Matthew) Linden and Alexandra Meek (Steven), a step-grandson Christopher Byrne; and six great-Grandchildren. There are also several nephews and nieces.

Her husband, Harry, and siblings Dorothy Cuthbertson, Lorine Luplow and Arnold Nuechterlein have preceded her in death.
